# **ACCEPTABLE ITEMS**

<u>Furniture</u>: couches, love seats, mattresses, box springs (\$10/ea.)

Chairs, tables, arm chairs (\$5/ea.)

<u>Appliances</u>: dryers, washers, stoves, water tanks (\$5/ea.)

Refrigerators, freezers, a/c units. (\$30/ea. Freon charge)

Metals or "Other" construction waste (should be no more than 75lbs and no longer than 6' to accommodate the Town garbage truck)

#### **NON-ACCEPTABLE ITEMS**

Toxic waste, organic waste, electronics, highly combustible items or explosive materials, biomedical waste, raw sewage or septic pumping and radioactive waste.

#### **DISPOSE OF:**

**TREE BRANCHES & COMPOST-** out at the lagoon in the correct piles.

Please ensure all items are neatly placed near the curb or by your regular garbage pick-up.

We thank you in advance for making all efforts to keep our Town clean.


